### Symptoms peak about 50 hours

- Tremor
- Agitation
- Fits often early multiple brief 30% have fits proceed to DTs if untreated
- sweating
- facial erythema
- tachycardia
- anorexia

Differential
acute schizophrenia
benzo withdrawal
CNS infection
hypoglycaemia
Sepsis
thyrotoxicosis
neuroleptic malignant syndrome

rare before 3rd day of abstinence severe end of withdrawal spectrum lasts 3-4/7 mortality 15% untreated **Autonomic**
